## I FRANCOROGLI DEL REGNO, GARIBALDI e LUOGOTENENZA

Presento una selezione da uno studio personale di oltre quarant'anni, selezione che è una delle più complete possibili dei francobolli del Regno di Napoli, di quello emesso da Garibaldi e di quello emesso dal Luogotenente Farini rispettivamente il 1° gennaio 1858, 6/11 e 6/12/1860.

I francobolli del Regno disegnati dal Masini, stampati in calcografia su un fondo con finissimo disegno ad ornato recano a sinistra un cavallo rampante (simbolo di Napoli), a destra una trinacria rappresentante la Sicilia e in mezzo in basso tre piccoli gigli per i Borboni regnanti; in cornice la scritta "BOLLO DELLA POSTA NAPOLETANA", in basso il valore (1/2 Grano, 1, 2, 5, 10, 20 e 50 Grana; cornici di forma diversa con identificazione mediante una lettera da G a I (iniziali del nome di Masini); unico colore in rosso e sue nuances per evitare la bandiera tricolore. Carta a mano filigranata della cartiera Tayani (BT) con gigli al centro e sui bordi "BOLLI POSTALI", foglio di 200 esemplari divisi da interspazio verticale. Usati dal 2 gennaio.

Presento due blocchi di 4 del saggio non utilizzato ordinato già dal 1841 e una selezione delle prove tipografiche del Masini (l'unica trafugata e posta su lettera fu intercettata e mai servì per posta). La stampa tipografica è molto meno costosa di quella calcografica.

Alle pagine 3 e 4 le tre lettere che completano tutti i valori usati nel primo giorno (UNICUM).

Di ogni valore dal più basso al più alto presento esemplari nuovi ed usati in multipli e su lettera con le varie nuances di colore appartenenti a tutte le tavole di stampa (2 per il ½, per il 5, 10 e per il 20, 3 per il 2 Grana e una sola per il 50 Grana con molte grandi rarità importanti.

Alle pagine dal 74 al 78 presento importanti e rare affrancature costituite da francobolli del medesimo valore appartenenti a Tavole differenti. Alle pagine 79 e 80 varietà di stampa e stampe rectoverso; pagina 81 stampa "smossa", 82 "difetti di allineamento", 83 e 84 esemplari con piega della carta, 85 e 86 esemplari con carta "crema" per maggior contenuto di paglia e esemplari "preamidati" per migliorare la nitidezza della stampa; alla pagina 87 due affrancature molto rare con la filigrana "BT" completa (sigla di Bonaventura Tayani- un solo per foglio).

Dalle pagine 88 a 107 una selezione dei "Falsi" per frodare la Posta dei valori 2, 10 e 20 Grana. Spiccano in questa selezione due lettere affrancate col "Falso" e con l'originale del medesimo valore (2+2 e 20+20). Questa sezione contiene il più importante gruppo di francobolli "Falsi" allo stato di nuovo.

Il 6 novembre 1860 fu utilizzato il francobollo da ½ Tornese ordinato da Garibaldi per ridurre la tariffa dei giornali da ½ Grano circa 2,5 Centesimi a ½ Tornese = 1 Centesimi circa.

A Napoli si stampavano circa 20 "giornali" diversi. Il francobollo fu ottenuto sostituendo la "G" con la "T" sulla metà (quindi 100 francobolli) destra della II Tavola del ½ Grano.

Presento uno dei dieci francobolli allo stato di nuovo (3 in Musei Esteri, il Giornale con il francobollo oblitterato il 6 novembre, primo giorno - 3 documenti noti) e una delle rarissime affrancatura di Doppio Porto.

Dalla stessa Tavola vennero cancellati i simboli Borbonici e vennero sostituiti da una croce, emblema dei Savoia. Ogni francobollo fu inciso in modo lievemente diverso.


Questi francobolli furono emessi il 6 dicembre (Luogotenenza Farini). Presento uno dei rarissimi Primo Giorno d'Uso certificato da lettera scritta al retro di fascetta con "risparmio" di 7/8 del Porto dovuto, il decalco con interspazio che mostra la "G" della mezza Tavola non modificata, una selezione di rari bollini oblitteratori, l'unica Filigrana "Simisoide" e l'unica "BT" su esemplare nuovo, Porti multipli (4 Croci corrispondenti a 1 Grano) e 8 corrispondenti a 2 Grana (ENTRAMBE AFFRANCATURE UNICHE) (Nota un blocco di 8 sciolto). Presento anche una affrancatura Mista con francobolli Borbonici e l'UNICA UNIVALEORE con i francobolli SPECIALI emessi PER LE PROVINCE NAPOLETANE.
